

News on Kansai Airport from SPARC LOC (7 September 2018)

Partial operation of the domestic flight will be started on 7 September, using the runway which was safe. This is a good news. The Prime Minister stated that the restoration work by three stages of "emergency", "provisional", "full-scale" to resume full-scale including restoration of the bridge and international flight etc. will be shown on 7 September (from digital.asahi.com). This will be a reliable and important information for us. I will report this tomorrow.

The railway bridge part of the connecting bridge was also pushed by the collision of the tanker and the railroad was distorted. However the railway girder seems not to be damaged and usable if it is shifted to the original position. However, it is not clear when the repair is completed (from Mainichi.jp).

A lot of trees were blown down and a part of the city was suffered from blackout in Kyoto. However, they are fairly heading for recovery. Miyakomesse, the SPARC GA venue, is also operating normally.
