

News on Kansai Airport from SPARC LOC (9 September 2018)

The average number of international flights in 2017 was 334 per day. Compared with this, the number of flights on the 8th of September using Terminal 2 and B runway was less than 5%. A good news is that the first terminal (the south part) and A runway that suffered flood damage is expected to be recovered in a week. Three out of six transformer facilities were broken and a blackout occurred, but it turned out that it was possible to repair by just replacing parts. Gas has been already recovered.

The prospect of recovery of the connection bridge is the same as yesterday.

Miyakomesse, the SPARC GA venue, is operating normally. The SPARC GA 2018 will be held as scheduled.
