

### **News on Kansai Airport from SPARC LOC (14 September 2018)**

Good news.

Terminal 1 (T1), which was flooded and had a power outage, will be available on the south side from the 14th. Peach Aviation (APJ / MM) is in its full service from 14th using Terminal 2 (T2). JAL and ANA are currently partly operating using T2, but return to T1 from 14th. According to Kansai Airport Co., on the 14th, 34% of the total flights will be scheduled at T1. 29 international airlines (51% of normal) will operate 49 flights (31%). Five domestic airlines (83%) plan to operate 19 flights (44%). On the 20th, the total flight number of T1 will be recovered to 50%, namely, 37 international airlines (65%) will operate 64 flights (40%). For domestic flights, 34 flights (79%) of 6 airlines (100%) will be operated.

In addition, it was announced that the resume of the north side of T1 building would be finished on 21th of September Railway service of connecting bridge will also resume on the 21th. The restoration of the railway used by 50% of people visiting Kansai Airport and that of the whole Terminal 1 will greatly restore the airport function.

In summary, according to yesterday's announcements, although it is not still very certain, most international flights are expected to arrive at Kansai Airport just before starting SPARC GA 2018.
