"Japanese Thomas Edison", invented the first domestic madeX-ray machine. In 2002,

a member of the factory, Koichi Tanaka, achieved a novel prize in chemistry, thus becoming famous as a novel prize winning businessman.

For years, the place looked upon Kyoto's development and wished for grace uponthe people of Kyoto.

The beautiful building supported innovation of technology and contributed to Japan's rapid economic growth for years. 85 years after its' birth, in the year 2012,

the place was renovated in to a new facility, with the new name of "Fortune Garden Kyoto", and began a new page in the

history of Kyoto.




